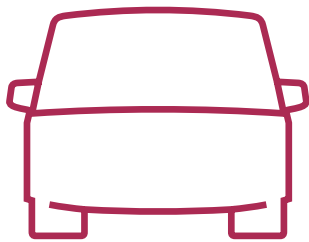


# Get ready for Brexit

## 1. EU Customers and risk
